In fall 1995 the first big concert tour in Austria, Germany and Poland featured the wonderful trumpeter and composer Kenny Wheeler and his music.

The music recorded at the end of the tour is exclusively written by Mr. Wheeler and commissioned by the UAJO.

After presenting the recording at the „International BB Festival in Lasberg“ 1996 and a 10 days tour in Austria, the UAJO and Kenny Wheeler was invited to 7 of the largest Jazzfestivals in Canada in 1997.

The festivals in Montreal, Toronto and Vancouver are some of the largest and most important jazz events in the world.

Since then the UAJO released 10 more CDs, played hundreds of concerts worldwide and appears also as organizer of BB- and Jazzworkshops and of a special jazz series in the Operahaus in Linz Upper Austria.

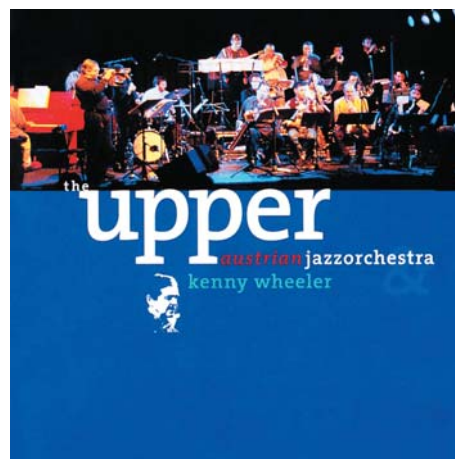
